

Reports Terms & Conditions

Effective Date: June 5th, 2019

Introduction

The present terms and conditions, which shall be interpreted in accordance with the laws of Texas, apply to:

1. Data, information and editorial content contained in Intratec Production Cost Reports ('Production Cost Reports' or 'Reports'); and
2. Data, information and/or editorial content complimentary to Production Cost Reports, provided as reports, presentations and/or spreadsheets ('Extra Analyses').

Glossary

In these terms and conditions:

"**Licensed Materials**" means the pricing data, price forecasts, market data, industry data, technology data and any other data, information and editorial content contained in Intratec Production Cost Reports, Extra Analyses, and/or Indexes & Pricing Data.

"**Customer**" means: individual, institutional or corporate purchaser of the Reports and /or Extra Analyses identified in the Order Form.

"**Subscriber**" means: individual, institutional or corporate subscriber of the Reports, Extra Analyses and /or Indexes & Pricing Data identified in the Order Form.

"**Authorized User**" means: the named individual(s) identified in the Order Form and/or employees of an institutional or corporate Customer or Subscriber identified in the Order Form. Customers and Subscribers are responsible for ensuring compliance by the respective Authorized Users with these terms and conditions.

"**Derived Content**" means materials created by or on behalf of the Customer, Subscriber, or Website Visitor, incorporating the Licensed Materials and/or Free Content in combination with other information and/or data.

"**Unauthorized**" in relation to a person means any person other than a Customer, a Subscriber or an Authorized User.

Production Cost Reports and Extra Analyses

Content & Data

Data, information, analyses and/or models presented in the Reports and Extra Analyses are prepared on the basis of publicly available information and non-confidential information disclosed by third parties. Intratec conducts analyses and prepares Reports and Extra Analyses for Customers, Subscribers and Authorized Users in conformance with generally accepted professional standards. Changes in factors upon which information, data and/or analyses presented in the Reports and Extra Analyses are based could affect the respective information, data and/or analyses.

Although the statements in the Reports and Extra Analyses are derived from or based on several sources that Intratec believe to be reliable, Intratec does not guarantee their accuracy, reliability, or quality; any such information, or resulting analyses, may be incomplete, inaccurate or condensed. All estimates included in the Reports and Extra Analyses are subject to change without notice. The Reports and Extra Analyses are for informational purposes only and are not intended to or should not be construed as advice or recommendations of any nature whatsoever.

Use & Sharing

Customer, Subscriber or Authorized User agrees it will not, without prior written consent of Intratec, represent, directly or indirectly, that Intratec Reports and/or Extra Analyses have been approved or endorsed by the other parties. In no event shall Intratec, its employees, representatives, resellers or distributors be liable to Subscriber, Authorized User or any other person or entity for any direct, indirect, special, exemplary, punitive, or consequential damages, including lost profits, based on breach of warranty, contract, negligence, strict liability or otherwise, arising from the use of the Reports and/or Extra Analyses, whether or not they or it had any knowledge, actual or constructive, that such damages might be incurred.

The use of Production Cost Reports and/or Extra Analyses information and/or data for any purposes not expressly permitted by these terms and conditions is subject to Intratec's prior written consent. Authorized User is not entitled to share Production Cost Reports and/or Extra Analyses information and/or data with third parties or affiliates, unless Authorized User obtains Intratec's prior written approval.

Passwords are for the personal use of the Authorized User to whom they are issued and may not be made available to others for the purpose of using Production Cost Reports and/or Extra Analyses. If Intratec suspects that a password is being used by an unauthorized person it may cancel the password

The Authorized User further agrees to refrain from any general release of the information presented in Production Cost Reports and/or Extra Analyses, so as to constitute passage of title into the public domain or otherwise jeopardize common law or statutory copyright.

Order, Payment & Delivery

Production Cost Reports may be ordered individually, from Intratec Report Store at Intratec Website, or through Production Cost Reports Subscription Plans.

Production Cost Reports may be purchased via credit cards. Customers using credit cards warrant that they have the authority to use the credit card and that the billing information provided is accurate, and authorize Intratec to charge the designated credit card for the total amount of the purchase, including any sales or similar taxes.

For high amount purchases, payments can be made via local bank transfers or wire transfers. For payments made via local bank transfers and wire transfers, payment confirmation may take some days, depending on banks transaction procedures.

Intratec Reports may be delivered as downloadable protected non-printable PDF digital files. The delivery format is set out in the respective Order Form. Reports are made available for download in a private area at Intratec website. It is the Customer's, Subscriber's and/or Authorized User's responsibility to ensure that it has the equipment necessary to access and/or download Production Cost Reports.

The delivery of each Report ordered from Intratec Reports store may take up to fifteen business days from the date in which the Report is ordered. The delivery time is set out in the respective Order Form.

The delivery of Reports associated with subscription plans will be made on a monthly basis. The Reports delivered under a subscription will be in accordance with the schedule for new Reports, presented at Intratec Website.

Standard Plan. This subscription plan permits a single individual to download Production Cost Reports as protected non-printable PDF digital files, delivered in accordance with the schedule presented for new Reports, at Intratec website. Reports will remain accessible during subscription term. Upon subscription expiration, the access to the reports is immediately interrupted. Private consultants, consulting firms, engineering companies, or any company whose business activity involves the sale of information, studies and/or professional advice are not allowed to subscribe to the Standard Plan.

Pro Plan. This subscription plan permits a single individual to download Production Cost Reports and Extra Analyses as non-printable PDF digital files, delivered in accordance with the schedule presented for new Reports, at Intratec website. Subscribers who select the option 'Reports Archive' will also have access to reports and analyses already released by Intratec in previous subscriptions, as presented at Intratec website. Reports will remain accessible during subscription term. Upon subscription expiration, the access to the reports is immediately interrupted.

Enterprise Plan. This subscription plan permits up to 5 (five) individuals from a single Company to download Production Cost Reports and Extra Analyses as non-printable PDF digital files, delivered in accordance with the schedule presented for new Reports, at Intratec website. Subscribers who select the option 'Reports Archive' will also have access to reports and analyses already released by Intratec in previous subscriptions, as presented at Intratec website. Subscribers may also order three bonus reports from Intratec store, at no additional cost, and clear questions about reports content with Intratec Team. Reports will remain accessible during subscription term. Upon subscription expiration, the access to the reports is immediately interrupted.

Upon subscription, the new Subscriber will have access to reports in the upcoming month. The subscription term starts counting upon the first reports delivery. The Subscriber will receive access to reports in the third week of every month until the end of the subscription term.

On expiry of a subscription without renewal, or on termination of a subscription for any reason during the subscription term, the Subscriber or Authorized User will no longer have access to Reports and Extra Analyses.

The purchase of Production Cost Reports and Extra Analyses from the Report Store and Subscriptions to Production Cost Reports at Intratec Website are conditioned upon the acceptance of the Refund Policy, available at www.intratec.us/docs/intratec-refund-policy.pdf.

Availability of Reports and Extra Analyses

Reports and Extra Analyses purchased individually from the Report Store at Intratec Website will be accessible for 365 days after report delivery, in a private area at Intratec website.

Reports provided under a subscription plan will be accessible during the subscription term, in a private area at Intratec website.

Intratec shall use all reasonable endeavors in accordance with good industry practice to ensure that Reports are available to Authorized Users excluding downtime for regular or emergency maintenance which shall be kept to a minimum.

No Notice of Updates

Intratec reserves the right to modify or change these terms and conditions from time to time without notice. The latest version will be available on the Site. Your election to continue use of the Site, after the date of posting of these modifications to the terms and conditions constitutes acceptance of those modifications.

Suspension and Termination

Intratec may without notice and without compensation suspend access to any Report, Extra Analysis and/or Indexes & Pricing Data by one or more Customer, Subscriber or Authorized User if; (i) the Customer, Subscriber or Authorized User is in default of its payment obligations; or (ii) Intratec has reasonable grounds to suspect the Customer, Subscriber or Authorized User to be in breach of these terms and conditions.

On expiry of a subscription without renewal, or on termination of a subscription for any reason during the subscription term, the Subscriber or Authorized User shall cease all use of the Licensed Materials Immediately.

Expiry or termination of a subscription shall be without prejudice to the accrued rights and Obligations of the parties.

Intellectual Property Rights

All intellectual property rights, including but not limited to copyright and other proprietary rights, in Intratec Reports, Extra Analyses and the Licensed Materials are and remain the property of Intratec Solutions LLC and its Affiliates.
